# **NURSING STANDING ORDER**



## **Laboratory Orders**

When a patient arrives for an appointment with a provider the clinical staff member will follow these guidelines to obtain the appropriate tests prior to the provider seeing the patient:

#### PHYSICAL EXAM (Non-Family and Subsequent Family Planning)

• At Provider's discretion

#### INITIAL FAMILY PLANNING VISIT

- Obtain an in-house urinalysis
- Obtain an in-house hemoglobin
- · Obtain blood for RPR and HIV
- For patients of African-American descent (male or female), obtain blood for a Sickle Cell Screen if the chart does not already contain the result of such test or patient unable to produce results of previous testing
- Obtain blood for Rubella if within child bearing age

#### PATIENTS WITH DIABETES MELLITUS

• Obtain an in-house Hemoglobin A1C if the patient is either a new patient to the clinic or has not had the A1C level performed in the previous 90 days

#### PATIENTS WITH IRREGULAR OR MISSED MENSES

Obtain an in-house urine pregnancy test

# PATIENTS WITH LOW BACK PAIN, DYSURIA, OR SIGNS OF URINARY TRACT INFECTION

• Obtain an in-house, midstream, clean-catch urinalysis

### PATIENTS WITH GLUCOSURIA NOTED ON URINALYSIS

- Obtain an in-house Glucose level
- Record results in the designated space for either Fasting or Random Blood Glucose

This policy shall remain in effect for all patients of HealthPoint/BVCAA until rescinded or until December 31, 2015.
